## Biography

Son of [Henry Forster](#) and [Rachel \(Douglas-Scott-Montagu\) Forster](#). John was born Chelsea in 1893.<sup>[1]</sup> He was baptized at St. Mary in Lewisham.

He enlisted in the 2nd Battalion of the Kings Royal Rifle Corps, achieving the rank of 2nd Lieutenant, and was killed in action at the First Battle of Aisne in Picardie, France. He is buried at La Ferte-sous-Jouarre, Departement de Seine-et-Marne, Île-de-France, France.<sup>[2][3][4]</sup> His brother also fell, and John is remembered on his tomb at Exbury.
